
THE ENVIRONMENT

OBJECTIVES

At the end of the presentations, the participants will:

- 1. Recognize age implications for eye donation and list some medical conditions which result in deferral.
- 2. Understand the impact of negative pleural pressure swings on cardiac physiology during obstructive sleep apnea and understand the interaction of chronic pain therapy and sleep disordered breathing.
- 3. Discuss the consequences of sleep deprivation and disruption in the hospital, the role of sleep and its impact on ventilator care and post-operative management.
- 4. Describe current AARC activities, patient advocacy updates, and KRCS activities.
- 5. Learn ten timeless life skills that will maximize your real net worth.
- 6. Home Medical Speaker
- 7. Identify four goals of home NIV, identify home NIV candidates, and explain the use of NIV in chronic respiratory insufficiency.
- 8. Identify the normal capnography waveform and discuss variations in the waveform based on the patient's cardiopulmonary status. Describe the application of quantitative waveform capnography in the monitoring of patients in various clinical areas.
- 9. Describe the health care status in Ghana and the future of respiratory therapy in Ghana.
- 10. Discuss basic cerebral hemodynamics, the effects of mechanical ventilation and suctioning, and the transport and extubation of the TBI patient.
- 11. Identify barriers to adequate pain relief and describe persistent pain causes and symptoms.
- 12. Understand the definition of obesity hypoventilation syndrome, recognize clinical features, and describe different treatment options.
