

# **Objectives**

- 1. Quality Improvement to increase awareness and to reduce High-Flow Nasal Cannula overuse
- 2. Provide useful tools for RT's to implement in their daily practice
- 3. Expand on the current asthma definition and discuss testing recommended for diagnosing asthma
- 4. Define endotype and phenotype of asthma as well as describe characteristics and biomarkers of identified endotypes and phenotypes
- 5. Learn the role and function of the NBRC
- 6. Understand organ donation from the side of the family
- 7. Participants will explain the roles of the speechlanguage pathologist in the acute care setting
- 8. Participants will summarize the importance of interdisciplinary consultation between speech-language pathologists and respiratory therapists for optimal pa-
- 9. Discuss how to use critical thinking, assessment, and critical analysis of various situations
- 10. Explain how CO2 levels can influence cerebral blood flow and IVH
- 11. Identify how continuous transcutaneous CO2 monitoring can help support brain function and protect the lung of
- 12. Discuss the mechanisms of nano-preemie lung injury
- 13. Describe how high frequency ventilation can be used to both treat and prevent lung injury
- 14. Understand the limited utility of salvage maneuvers in the face of severe hypoxemia
- 15. Participants will be provided evidence-based procedures that should be considered with severe hypoxemia


